



In 2023 Victoria College students celebrated another year of outstanding results, with the highest number of top grades in A Level entries in more than a decade.

Extended Project Qualification (EPQ)

Alongside A levels, our students can choose to take an extra qualification that is recommended by UCAS as extra preparation for university.

For the EPQ, students choose a topic of their choice, carry out research and either write an extended essay or create an artefact.

Beyond the classroom

Our world of opportunity awaits

Victoria College offers excellent opportunities alongside the academic curriculum. If you have a particular interest in music, sport, languages, drama or many other areas, then you will find a niche here to build your skills to the highest level and develop new talents. All Year 7 boys learn an orchestral instrument and we have an exceptional programme of co-curricular activities including: archery, scuba diving, surfing and golf.

Sport is a particular strength at Victoria College and our students regularly represent the Island at football, rugby, cricket and other competitive events.

The Combined Cadet Force (CCF) is a thriving hub for a wide range of military themed and adventurous activities including a number of off-island trips. We have our own shooting range and many of our marksmen compete in national competitions with great success.

Wellbeing and resilience are an important part of education for everyone. We know that young people learn best when they feel happy and secure. Each boy has a tutor within the school's House structure who will be their guide in pastoral and personal issues. In turn, boys can train as Peer Mentors to offer support to younger students in the school.

Enrichment

Alongside academic lessons, Victoria College aims to enrich the lives of all our students. Before, during and after school there are a range of activities in a variety of cerebral, sporting and creative disciplines on offer.

In addition, students in Years 7 & 8 follow an enrichment programme that encompasses first aid, oracy, stop motion animation, study skills, as well as additional creative subjects.

From Year 9, students begin their Duke of Edinburgh's Bronze Award with many going on to complete Silver and Gold. In the Sixth Form, students take part in a series of formal electives, including revision techniques, first aid, health education, current affairs and local government (preparing to vote), mindfulness, cooking skills, public speaking and sports coaching.

Throughout all years, there are also opportunities for students to represent their House in a wide range of events, ranging from drama to badminton, and from scavenger hunts to art.
