In return, Victoria College agrees to deliver the benefits of Foundation Partnership as stated overleaf to your organisation and to apply the contributed funds* directly to the Victoria College Foundation, for use in accordance with its Trust Deed, which is chiefly to benefit Victoria College and Victoria College Preparatory School.

In the rare and unlikely event that either party should suffer significant, negative publicity in the media, there is liberty to apply for a visual disassociation of the parties' brands, but not for a refund of any funds contributed by you; as such funds provide vital funding for student bursaries.

Regarding the 'Graduate K.I.T.' programme, which is available to Platinum Foundation Partners, Victoria College collects student leaver contact data for the legitimate purpose of maintaining its alumni database. Each leaver on the 'Graduate K.I.T.' list has provided his consent to be emailed directly by the school's Foundation Partners regarding graduate opportunities beyond College, on the understanding that they may directly unsubscribe from the Foundation Partner's mailing list, when contacted, should they wish to do so. The Foundation Partner assumes GDPR compliance responsibility upon the receipt of the data.
