Exam results

GCSE results 2025

This year we were delighted to report that Grade 9s increased from last year to 12% and over a quarter of all grades received were 9s or 8s. We saw our hightest percentage of grades 9 - 6 (the equivalent of the old A* - B) in a number of years and over 96% of all grades were in the 9 - 4 range. Once again, our Year 11 cohort attained a positive value-added score above national benchmarks and were placed in the top 10% of UK schools in terms of progress. This highlights the effort from the students and the quality of support from the staff.

Dr Hughes said "I am very proud of this group of young men. The work put in over the last two years, and the progress seen in that time, has been genuinely impressive. Whilst I am pleased that over a quarter of all grades were in the very top bracket of Grades 9 or 8, there are notable success stories across the range of academic outcomes and so many of the students have outperformed their baseline expectations. My sincere thanks go to my staff that guided the boys so well, and to our parental body that offered support at home. We are excited to welcome many of the cohort back to join our Sixth Form in September, where they will be joined by external applicants from 11 -16 island schools and from overseas."

A Level results 2025

Victoria College's 2025 A-level results were at record highs in all headline bands (not including COVID years). A*s increased by 7% on last year to 20%, A* - A% improved to 45%. A* - B% were up to 74% and A* - C% saw a very pleasing 91%. 16 of our students - 23% of the whole cohort - achieved all A* or As in their results, with two attaining an impressive four A* grades profile. These results place Victoria College in the top 10% for progress across all schools in the United Kingdom.

Dr Hughes said "I am delighted to see record results for this wonderful cohort of young men, and could not be more proud of their hard work and perseverance over the last few years. There are so many success stories in their group and they leave with outstanding qualifications that will pave the way for the rest of their lives, in whatever ventures they embark on. I am grateful for the care and guidance from my staff, and for the support of the parents, who have all provided the excellent foundations on which these record-breaking successes have been built."



Bursaries

Victoria College is a Government of Jersey fee-paying school. For the academic year, September 2024 - 2025, fees are £2,880 per term (£8,640 per year) and for Victoria College Preparatory School, they are £2,840 per term/£8520 per academic year. We aim to offer an education to all talented young men in Jersey so if financing might affect your son's ability to attend then please get in touch.

A number of means-tested bursaries are available to help your family pay the school fees if your household yearly income is under £82,000. Please note that the amount of support that can be offered will vary the closer your income is to this figure and we now ask all applicants to contribute something towards the fees. Year 7 scholarships programme

Victoria College scholarships differ from bursaries in that the scholarships are to recognise and support excellence in music, academia or sport and are not means-tested. There is a standard stipend of £250 per year for each scholar which is to be spent directly on items or opportunities linked to supporting excellence in each scholar's chosen area. There are three scholarships on offer, and each will be held for two years:

- 1. Academic scholarship
- 2. Music scholarship
- 3. Sports scholarship

What scholarships are available?

Academic scholarship

Students achieving a mean score of over 120 in their Year 5 CATS results are eligible to apply. Candidates should demonstrate:

- Strong academic ability
- Commitment to learning
- Enthusiasm for the opportunities offered at Victoria College
- Applicants will attend an assessment afternoon, including a problem-solving paper and an interview with the Assistant Head: Curriculum and Learning

Award:

- £250 contribution towards books/school supplies
- Blazer badge
- Opportunity to write an article for The Victorian magazine
- Role as a College representative at the annual Open Day



Music scholarship

Applicants must demonstrate musical talent through at least one instrument or vocal ability, as well as a strong interest in participating in the full range of musical opportunities at Victoria College. Assessments will include:

- Two prepared pieces per instrument
- Aural tests and sight-reading
- Interview with the Director of Music

Award:

- £250 contribution towards music lessons or equipment
- Blazer badge
- Opportunity to write an article for The Victorian magazine
- Invitations to perform at Open Day and the Summer Concert
- Participation in the school choir and/or ensembles (depending on musical strengths)

Sports scholarship

Applicants should demonstrate competence in at least two sports. Candidates must:

- Offer at least two sports at a good level of competence
- Submit a sporting CV for consideration
- Attend an afternoon of fitness tests and interviews at VCJ
- Submit a reference from their current coach/trainer

Award:

- £250 contribution towards sports equipment
- Blazer badge
- Opportunity to write an article for The Victorian magazine
- Role as a sporting ambassador for Victoria College
- Supporting the Director of Sport in running the House Sports Programme

- Scholarships are open to students who have been offered and accepted a place at Victoria College for Year 7 entry in 2026
- Application forms will be distributed in the second half of the spring term
- Deadline for applications: Saturday 9th May 2026
- Scholarship assessment afternoon: second half of the summer term
- Awards will be confirmed before the end of the summer term

Note: Each scholarship is awarded for two years. Scholars must reapply thereafter.
